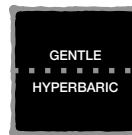

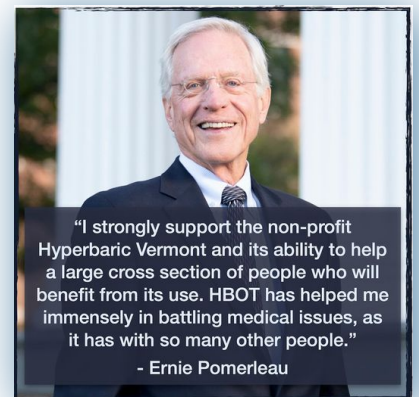

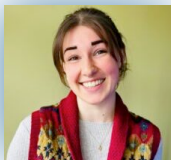


Megan Fogarty, Nurse Practitioner

Miranda has a degree in journalism from Penn State University, and hopes HBOT will be part of a larger conversation about helping people find health, hope, and equal access to healing.

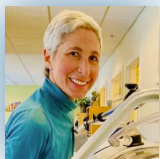


Zoie Weisendanger, Patient Care Associate
